

Dance Excellence Academy

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Program Overview

The Dance Excellence Academy has been designed to challenge students with a learning experience in dance that focuses on technique and performance. Students will be given the opportunity to further develop their knowledge and skills across a range of styles including jazz, contemporary, lyrical, hip hop and musical theatre. Students will train in purpose built facilities with expertly designed units of work that focus on building teamwork skills, communication and confidence. The program places an emphasis on commitment and professionalism from the students whilst encouraging them to apply the school values of respect, responsibility and perseverance to their learning.

Curriculum & Program Details

The Dance Excellence Academy runs three (3) lessons per week. The individual talents of the students will be nurtured by our specialist teachers while they work through the two areas of dance; making & responding. Over the school year students will participate in:

- Technique lessons
- Strength and flexibility sessions
- Teacher/Guest Artist taught routines
- Choreography workshops
- Theoretical Responding units

Dance Academy students will also compete with their class at local eisteddfods and competitions across the year. Dance Excellence Academy students will be invited to audition for the extra-curricular dance teams. Training sessions for these teams fall outside of school hours (before and after school). Auditions for these teams commence in Term 1, week 2 of the new school year. These teams compete and perform regularly at a range of internal and external events across South-East Queensland.


CLASS SIZES:

Audition Process

The RVSSC Dance Excellence Academy entry is competitive. Students will be required to participate in an audition where candidates will take part in stretching, technical exercises plus learning and performing a short dance routine. Candidates are assessed on the following:

- Technique
- Flexibility
- Strength
- Ability to pick up and retain chorography
- Performance skills

Please note that when selecting suitable students for the Dance Excellence Academy year 7 intake several factors are considered. This includes not only the student's performance at the audition sessions but also their most recent report card to give an overall picture of the student. In school reports we look at the students grade in English and this course has a theoretical component plus their effort and behaviour across all subjects.

Maintaining position

Student performance is regularly monitored. Students must maintain academic standards and display suitable behaviour and effort across all subjects, whilst in the program. Students must uphold the school representation policy. The College Principal reserves the right to withdraw students from the Dance Excellence Academy program at any time.
